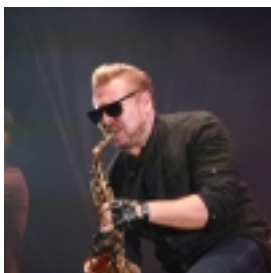
More than 1,000 people came to spend the evening in the entourage of native music.

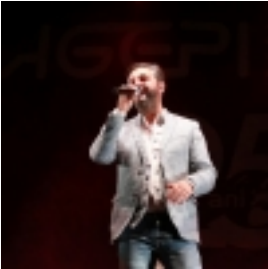

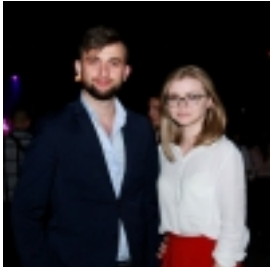
