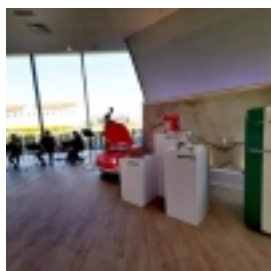
On Saturday, 23 March this year, was inaugurated the Italian Design Day in Moldova, an event with the main title "Design and the City of the Future"

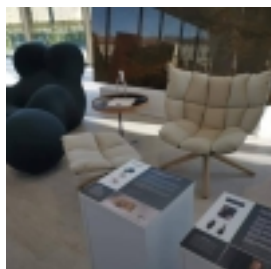
