In the period of February 7-12, 2007, in Kishinev on the territory of IEC “MOLDEXPO” (str. Ghiocailor,1) there will take place the VI Universal National Exhibition “Fabricated in Moldova”. The exhibition takes place under the patronage of the Government of RM and is carried out under the title “Moldovan trademark – European quality”. The aim of the exhibition consists in the contribution to the creation of favourable conditions for maintain the national producer, development of the competitiveness thereof, as well as for the promotion of the image of the Republic of Moldova.
