Creative Women Entrepreneurs Forum was opened by the President of GEN Moldova, Olesea Fortuna, who spoke about the importance of creativity in business.

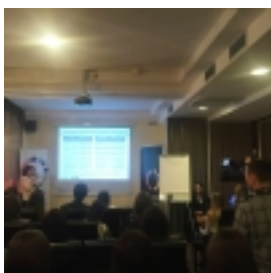
