The Director General of the State Agency on Intellectual Property (AGEPI), Eugeniu Rusu, today presented the diploma and the grand prix to Alina Mustovici, pupil of the Theoretical Lyceum "Onisifor Ghibu" from Orhei, who won first place in the Contest in the Field of Intellectual Property for Young People.

The competition, now in its fifth edition, took place in three stages, during the period April - December 2021, and was organized by AGEPI, in partnership with the Ministry of Education and Research of the Republic of Moldova, the State Office for Inventions and Trademarks of Romania and the Romanian Copyright Office. The Contest was attended by 49 pupils from all regions of the country.

In the final stage, Alina Mustovici impressed the jury with a video presentation on how to create a brand, how to strengthen the company's reputation and how the trademark helps customer loyalty, using the example of two local brands in Orhei.

The Director General of AGEPI Eugeniu Rusu, congratulated the winner and thanked her for her ingenuity and creativity.
