Today, the State Agency on Intellectual Property celebrated Europe Day, participating in the “European Village” organized in the Great National Assembly Square and in the courtyard of the Government of the Republic of Moldova, together with other state institutions, the Delegation of the European Union to the Republic of Moldova, the embassies of the European Union Member States, EU-funded projects, civil society organizations and the entire pro-European community in the Republic of Moldova.

The event was officially opened with speeches by Igor Grosu, Alexandru Munteanu and Iwona Piórko, who later visited the stands of the embassies of the EU Member States, European projects and participating public institutions.

AGEPI was present at the stand arranged under the auspices of the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Moldova, contributing, together with other public authorities, to the promotion of European values and the benefits of European integration for the citizens of the Republic of Moldova.
